It is the end of another year, and I thought I would reflect on what was accomplished this past season at Lions Camp Badger.

- * The most expansive project was the major electrical system upgrade. Power had to be cut to most of the camp over a weekend while two main shut-offs were installed. The camp needed these shut-offs to make it more safe for campers and staff and help us become American Camp Association compliant.
- * The Collins-Conroy Lodge was another project that continued throughout spring until September. Volunteers started working on April 12 with District E1, then IBM, and followed by Dansville Lions, Maple City Lions and several individuals.
- * Cabin #20 was a major job for a long weekend. This was done with the help of Greenfield Lions, Lee V. on the backhoe, and myself.
- * Cabin #15 received a new tin roof courtesy of the Gasport and Newfane Lions.
- * Cabins #3, 9, 12, 22 had new ceilings installed.
- * Cabins #1, 6, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 20 had properly-sized backdoors installed. To meet code, all doors are now 36" wide and all but two were made with rough cut lumber that we had on hand and matches the outside of the cabin.
- * Cabin #19 saw Verizon employees install another ramp.
- * Cabin #6, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15, 20, plus 5 rooms in the staff hotel were all painted white inside with some of the floors painted gray.
- * The trailer received a mini-makeover in the spring and got some needed furniture (from other areas of camp)
- * The foot bridge that crossed the swamp to the old campground below the Lake-house was rebuilt.
- * More brush was cleared around the YAPS cabins near the parking lot.

What a great Holiday gift to the camp! Your volunteerism, your time and effort spent here at the camp is such a gift. We are grateful. Thanks to all!
