## **LIONS CAMP BADGER 2024 SESSIONS**

| June 30-July 5             | Young Adult Badgers<br>(ages 18-25)                        | This session for our youngest adults is full of action and includes activities such as music, swimming, fishing, boating, arts & crafts, athletics, and evening programs.   |

| July 7-12                  | Buddy Badgers 1:1<br>(ages 6 - 55+)                        | This program offers 1:1 staff support for campers who benefit from maximum physical or behavioral assistance. The pace is slower and the environment quieter, allowing campers who find larger groups challenging to succeed in this smaller, supported setting.  |
| July 14-19                 | Senior Badgers I<br>(ages 18+)                             | Recommended for ages 26-40, but all over 18 are welcome. Our "middle" adults enjoy all of the traditional camp activities, plus more opportunities for individual choices in programming. Social events are a big part of our week!   |
| July 21-23                 | Family Camp 1 For families with children mostly 18 or over | Bring your family to camp! Each family has their own cabin and we provide staff support for activities such as swimming, boating, fishing, arts & crafts, etc.  |
| July 24-26                 | Family Camp 2 For families with children mostly under 18   | Family Camp is fully inclusive and open to person(s) with a disability, their siblings, parents/caregivers and an additional support person if needed. Enjoy networking with other families and an opportunity to bond with yours!  |
| July 28-Aug 2              | Junior Badgers<br>(Children's Camp)<br>(ages 6-17 only)    | Our youngest campers will be placed in cabins by age, and the program is carefully structured to keep them busy and engaged They will enjoy all things "camp", such as swimming, boating, cookouts, music, arts and crafts, social time, and athletics.   |
| Aug 4-9                    | Senior Badgers II<br>(ages 18+)                            | Recommended for ages 41-60+, but all over 18 are welcome. Our oldest adults enjoy all of the traditional camp activities, plus more opportunities for individual choices in programming. Quite often, they enjoy assisting with community service projects and planning their own social activities. The pace of this group tends to be a bit slower as compared to the younger groups. |
| 1) July 7-12<br>2) Aug 4-9 | Vocational Food<br>Service Program<br>(18+)                | <b>Returning campers ages 18+</b> may join us to learn employment and food service skills. Campers must be able to function within a 4:1 camper to counselor setting. Campers will receive food service instruction and training during the day in addition to regular programming in the afternoons and evenings. <b>Spots are limited.</b>  |
